


Use of Finger or Apple Pencil to draw or write.

Finger:

Markup Tool - 3 dots at bottom

Draw with Finger - ON

Pencil Setting Only Draw with Apple Pencil - OFF
Scribble - OFF

Now back to Note and your finger will work with the tools.

Apple Pencil:

1. Writing turns into text

Markup Tool - 3 dots at bottom
Draw with Finger - OFF
Pencil Setting Only Draw with Apple Pencil - ON
Scribble - **ON**

Now back to Note

Markup Tool - choose the Text Pencil tool (the one on the top with a T)

Now what you write will turn into text.

2. Writing stays looking like you wrote it.

Markup Tool - 3 dots at bottom
Draw with Finger - OFF
Pencil Setting Only Draw with Apple Pencil - ON
Scribble - **OFF**

Now back to Note

Markup Tool - choose the Text Pencil tool (the one on the top with a T)

Now what you write will stay as you wrote it.
